BRITAIN is the worst-performing western - democracy in Privacy Intemational's surveilance league table. It ranks 36 countries - incluxing the 25 EUmember states, according to their ability to protect privacy. Points were awarded across a range of 13 national practices, such as statutory and constitutional protections, the use of ID cards and CCTV cameras and democratic safeguards. Five points denoted no invasive policies and one point extensive surveillance. The highest scores were achieved by Germany and Canada. Britain was in the bottom five in the 'black' category of countries demonstrating 'endemic surveillance'. Despite having no comprehensive national privacy law, the United States scored higher than the UK. Thailand and the Philippines also scored higher than the UK Argentina scored higher than 20 of the 25 EU countries.
